Wednesday 29th August: Champions Breakfast – Local Developments & Skills

Chesterfield Champions event had a chance to hear about progress at Northern Gateway and also the Elder Way development, which will soon be home to Premier Inn, a gym and 6 restaurants.

Presentations highlighted how Chesterfield Borough Council has been maximising opportunities for local companies to win contracts for developments such as Elder Way, as well as focusing on the skills needed to keep the town growing and developing.
