
### <u>Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> January – Chesterfield & Destination Chesterfield – Your</u> View

The event started with a welcome from Dom Stevens, Destination Chesterfield Manager, who gave updates on a range of campaigns, including Christmas in Chesterfield. During this welcome, delegates were given the statistics and feedback from key events such as the Christmas light switch on as well as an insight into what's planned as part of the Love Chesterfield activity for 2022.

Josh Marsh, Destination Chesterfield Coordinator, spoke with David Beckford of Pronto Paints and Alison Bridge of MLS Contracts on the Rebrik Chesterfield 10K. They detailed new plans for a 5k the day before and what's planned for the 2022 Well-being Challenge.

We heard from Hannah Bowdler, Relationship Fundraiser for Junction Arts, who reflected on the companies' projects over the last two years and looked ahead to the event being delivered by them this year, including the popular Tapton Lock Festival.
